

Privacy Policy

Please note that the Japanese version of this disclaimer is the official version.

The Toyooka Theater Festival Executive Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Executive Committee”) establishes the following Privacy Policy in accordance with the Act on the Protection of Personal Information and will endeavor to handle and manage personal information appropriately.

1. Personal Information

Personal information refers to information concerning an individual, such as address, name, date of birth, telephone number, and email address, that can identify a specific individual. This also includes information that can be cross-checked with other information and thereby identify a specific individual.

2. Collection of Personal Information

When collecting personal information, the Executive Committee will, in principle, collect information provided voluntarily by the individual. In collecting personal information, the Executive Committee will clarify the purpose of collection and collect such information only within the scope necessary to achieve that purpose.

3. Purpose of Collection and Use of Personal Information

The purposes for which personal information is collected and used are as follows. If personal information is to be used for any purpose not listed below, the Executive Committee will notify the individual and obtain their consent again.

- Responses to and notifications regarding inquiries, applications, and various requests
- Announcements and information regarding events organized by the Executive Committee

4. Access Analytics Tool

This website uses “Google Analytics,” an access analytics tool provided by Google. Google Analytics uses cookies to collect data. This data is collected anonymously and does not identify any individual.

5. Disclosure and Provision of Personal Information to Third Parties

The Executive Committee will not provide personal information to third parties, except in cases where the consent of the individual has been obtained, where such disclosure or provision is based on the Act on the Protection of Personal Information or other laws and regulations, or where any of the following applies:

- When disclosure or provision is requested by a court, an administrative agency, or a person entrusted by an administrative agency, based on laws and regulations
- When it is necessary for the protection of a person's life or body, and it is difficult to obtain the consent of the individual
- When it is necessary to cooperate with a national government agency, a local public entity, or a person entrusted by either of them in carrying out affairs prescribed by laws and regulations, and obtaining the consent of the individual may impede the execution of such affairs
- When the Executive Committee is otherwise deemed to have a legal obligation to disclose such information

6. Management of Personal Information

The Executive Committee will take appropriate measures to prevent leakage, unauthorized use, falsification, and other improper handling of personal information. Personal information that no longer needs to be retained will be securely and promptly destroyed or deleted.

When outsourcing part of its operations to an external contractor, the Executive Committee will conclude an agreement with the contractor regarding the appropriate handling of personal information and will supervise the contractor to ensure such appropriate handling.

If an individual requests confirmation, correction, or deletion of the personal information collected about them, the Executive Committee will respond promptly.
